A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE RURAL ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT CENTER, INCORPORATED, FOR JOB TRAINING IN
EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$25,000 to the Opportunities Industrialization Center of Wilson, Incorporated, for its ongoing job training programs; and
- (2) \$25,000 to the Opportunities Industrialization Center, Incorporated, in Rocky Mount, for its ongoing job training programs; and
- (3) \$25,000 to the Opportunities Industrialization Center of Pitt-Greenville, N.C., Inc., for its ongoing job training programs; and
- (4) \$25,000 to the Kinston-Lenoir Opportunities Industrialization Center, Incorporated, for its ongoing job training programs; and
- (5) \$25,000 to the Halifax-Northampton Opportunities Industrialization Center, Incorporated, for its ongoing job training programs.

1 The Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall report quarterly to the
2 Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of funds allocated
3 in this section.

4 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
