2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE REGULATION OF WATER SUPPLY
3	WATERSHEDS DOES NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN WATERSHEDS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Notwithstanding any other law, the provisions of G.S. 143-214.5
6	shall not apply to any water supply watershed area classified as WS-III that: (i) includes
7	within the watershed the headwaters of a river that ultimately converges with other rivers
8	to form a major river that flows west into another state, and (ii) is located within two
9	adjacent counties that have a combined area of 467 square miles, have a combined
10	population of approximately 29,367, share western borders with another state, have a
11	national park running through the counties, are both located in the same two-member
12	State House of Representatives district and the same two-member State Senate district,
13	and one of the adjacent counties has a point of elevation of at least 3,589 feet above sea
14	level.
15	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
