

1 Sec. 2. To the extent practical, the Commission shall use the materials and
2 resources developed during the 1993-94 study of State purchasing by the LRC
3 Committee on State Purchasing.

4 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Assembly
5 the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for fiscal year 1995-96 to be allocated to
6 the Legislative Research Commission for a study of State purchasing.

7 Sec. 4. The Commission shall make a final report to the 1995 Session (1996
8 Regular Session).

9 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
