**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR MEAT AND POULTRY INSPECTION.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of one hundred thirty-four thousand three hundred eighty-one dollars (\$134,381) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thirty-four thousand three hundred eighty-one dollars (\$134,381) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the cost of inspecting wholesale meat operations and wholesale poultry operations in order to maintain an inspection program that satisfies the requirements of the Federal Meat Inspection Act, as codified in scattered sections of 21 U.S.C., as amended, and the federal Poultry Products Inspection Act, 21 U.S.C. §§ 451-469, as amended.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
