2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE A ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION FOR ANY STUDENT WHO
3	BRINGS CERTAIN WEAPONS ONTO SCHOOL PROPERTY AND TO ALLOW
4	THE SUPERINTENDENT TO MODIFY THE SUSPENSION FOR CHILDREN
5	WITH SPECIAL NEEDS OR BY PROVIDING AN ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL
6	SETTING.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. G.S. 115C-391 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
9	"(<u>d1</u>) <u>A local board of education shall suspend for 365 days any student who brings a</u>
10	weapon, as defined in G.S. 14-269.2(b) and (g), onto school property. The local board of
11	education upon recommendation by the superintendent may modify this suspension
12	requirement on a case-by-case basis which includes, but is not limited to, the procedures
13	set out in G.S. 115C-112 and may also provide educational services to any student
14	suspended pursuant to this subsection in an alternative school setting or in another setting
15	that provides educational and other services."
16	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective August 1, 1995, and applies to any student
17	who brings a weapon onto school property on or after that date.
