A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE DISTRICTS FOR THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

MECKLENBURG COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Mecklenburg County is divided into single-member electoral districts for the purpose of electing members of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education. The districts are as follows:

Sec. 2. The districts for election of district members of the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners shall be the same as those for the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education as established by this act.

Sec. 3. In the event that the United States Court of Appeals or the United States Supreme Court reverses the opinion of the United States District Court which held invalid the districts established by Chapter 167 of the Session Laws of 1993, then this act is repealed and the districts established by Chapter 167 of the Session Laws of 1993 are revived as to any future election.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
