S 1 SENATE BILL 817 Short Title: Dispute Settlement Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Rand, Ballantine, Hobbs, Plexico, and Little. Referred to: Appropriations April 25, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR FIFTEEN DISPUTE SETTLEMENT CENTERS ACROSS THE STATE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative Office of the Courts the sum of two hundred seventy-three thousand five hundred dollars (\$273,500) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for new and additional funding for 15 dispute settlement centers throughout the State. Sec. 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be allocated for new funding for the Blue Ridge Dispute Settlement Center. The remaining funds shall be allocated for additional funding as follows:

- 13 \$5,000 for the Alamance County Dispute Settlement Center; (1) 14
  - \$25,000 for the Dispute Settlement Program of Charlotte/Mecklenburg; (2)
- 15 \$10,000 for the Cumberland County Dispute Settlement Center: (3)
