| 5 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 6 | Section 1. Article 2 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is amended by |
| 7 | inserting a new section to read: |
| 8 | " <u>§ 131E-7.1. Public hospitals' managed care development authorized.</u> |
| 9 | <u>A public hospital as defined in G.S. 159-39(a)</u> may acquire an ownership |
| 10 | interest, in whole or in part, in a managed care company, including a health maintenance |
| 11 | organization or preferred provider organization with which the public hospital is also |
| 12 | directly or indirectly a contracting provider. Ownership interest may be evidenced by the |
| 13 | ownership, or acquired by the purchase of, stock. This ownership or acquisition of stock |
| 14 | is the exercise of a health care function and is not the investment of idle funds within the |
| 15 | meaning of G.S. 159-30 and G.S.159-39(g)." |
| 16 | Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995, and applies to acquisitions on |
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17 or after that date.
