A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PERMIT EMPLOYERS TO CONDUCT ON-SITE DRUG TESTING
UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 95-232(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Approved laboratories: the examiner shall ~~use only approved laboratories for screening and confirmation of samples.~~ have the option of:

(1) Performing the screening test on-site, provided that samples which demonstrate a positive drug test result are sent to an approved laboratory for confirmation, or

(2) Having an approved laboratory perform both the screening and confirmation tests as provided in this section."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
