AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM IN THE FIELD OF VISUAL IMPAIRMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall establish a teacher training program in the field of visual impairments in order to provide appropriate instructional opportunities for children and youth of North Carolina with visual impairments.

- Sec. 2. Of the funds appropriated to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina for the 1995-96 fiscal year, the sum of three hundred ninety-two thousand dollars (\$392,000) shall be allocated for personnel and equipment, and facility, administrative, and other start-up costs for the initiation of this program.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$328,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for operating costs of this program, including personnel, equipment, and administrative and consulting costs.
- Sec. 4. This program shall become part of the Board of Governor's continuation budget request.
 - Sec. 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
