H 210. PHASE OUT TEACHER TENURE. TO PHASE OUT TEACHER TENURE. Amends GS 115C-325 to make that section (election to career status, grounds and procedure for disciplinary action) inapplicable to any person not attaining career status before ratification of act.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

- 1. Eliminates career status for all persons who have not attained career status prior to the effective date of the act. The current law local boards of education grant career status upon completion of three years of teaching.
- 2. No cost would be incurred by the state as a result of this bill.
- 3. Local boards of education should not incur additional costs, if career status is eliminated prospectively.
