HOUSE BILL 71

Short Title: Permanent Antique Auto Tags.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A ONE-TIME FEE FOR PERMANENT
REGISTRATION PLATES FOR HISTORIC VEHICLES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(11) reads as rewritten:

"(11) Historic Vehicle Owner. – Issuable for a motor vehicle that is at least 35 years old measured from the date of manufacture. The plate for an historic vehicle shall bear the word "Antique" unless the vehicle is a model year 1943 or older. The plate for a vehicle that is a model year 1943 or older shall bear the word "Antique" or the words "Horseless Carriage", at the option of the vehicle owner. These plates shall be issued for permanent use on a particular motor vehicle and shall be valid until the vehicle is registered by a new vehicle owner."

Sec. 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. –

(1) Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war.

1 (2) The one-time fee for a registration plate issued pursuant to G.S. 20-
2 79.4(11) shall be forty dollars (\$40.00).

3 (3) All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor
4 vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional
5 fee in the following amount:

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1996.
