1 2 AN ACT TO ALLOW FOR THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN SUBSIDIARIES OF 3 INSURERS OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. G.S. 58-16-20 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 58-16-20. Company owned or controlled by alien-foreign government prohibited 7 from doing business. 8 Any insurance company or other insurance entity which that is financially (a) owned or financially controlled by any alien or foreign government outside the continental 9 limits of the United States or the territories of the United States is hereby-prohibited from 10 11 doing any kind of insurance business in the State of North Carolina. For the purposes of this section, the term 'alien or foreign-'foreign government' is defined to mean-means any 12 foreign government or any state, province, municipality, or political subdivision of any 13 foreign government, and shall not be construed to apply to any insurance company 14 organized under the laws of a foreign nation which that is financially owned or financially 15 controlled by the private citizens or private business interest of such that foreign nation. 16

The Commissioner is hereby forbidden to grant a shall not license to any 17 (b)18 insurance company or other insurance entity which that is financially owned or financially controlled by any alien or-foreign government outside the continental limits of the United 19

States or the territories of the United States, or to-nor shall the Commissioner authorize 1 2 any such company or entity to transact any kind of insurance business in the State of 3 North Carolina. 4 Any insurance company or other insurance entity which that is financially (c)5 owned or financially-controlled by any alien or foreign government outside the continental 6 limits of the United States or the territories of the United States, or any representative or agent of any such company or entity which that violates the provisions of this section, 7 8 shall be-is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor. 9 (d)This section does not apply to the operating subsidiary of any insurance 10 company or other insurance entity, where the company or entity is owned or controlled by any foreign government outside the continental limits of the United States or the 11

12 territories of the United States, as long as the operating subsidiary is domesticated in and 13 licensed by another state of the United States as an insurer or reinsurer and as a separate

- 14 <u>subsidiary.</u>"
- 15 Section 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1997, and applies to acts 16 committed and applications for licensure submitted on or after that date.
