Short Title: Fire/Rescue Personnel Records Checks.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE MAY PERFORM
2 CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECKS TO FACILITATE BACKGROUND
3 INVESTIGATIONS FOR FIREFIGHTER AND RESCUE SQUAD APPLICANTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 114-19.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(e) The Department of Justice may provide to a local or volunteer fire department
7 or rescue squad a criminal history record check of any individual who applies for a
8 position as a volunteer member or career employee of the fire department or rescue
9 squad. The Department of Justice shall process these requests as voluntary noncriminal
10 justice criminal history records checks."

11 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
