The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter 699 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 682 of the 1995 Session Laws and by S.L. 1997-150, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 4. This act applies only to Alamance, Avery, Beaufort, Burke, Caldwell, Caswell, Craven, Cumberland, Haywood, Hyde, Jackson, McDowell, Orange, Pasquotank, Pitt, Rockingham, Swain, Macon, Henderson, Transylvania, Union, and Wilkes Counties."

Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1998, and applies to
