A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE
STUDY COMMISSION ON PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO DIRECT THE STATE
BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT RULES PRESCRIBING THE
EXTRACURRICULAR DUTIES ASSIGNED TO FIRST-YEAR TEACHERS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules prescribing the type and number of extracurricular duties assigned to first-year teachers beginning with the 1998-99 school year. It is strongly recommended that new teachers be given no extracurricular duty in order to have an opportunity to develop into skilled professionals.

Section 2. The State Board of Education shall report to the Legislative Study Commission on Public Schools prior to October 1, 1998, on its progress in implementing this act.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
