- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local 6 School Administrative Units the sum of fifty-three million six hundred forty-three 7 thousand three hundred forty-three dollars (\$53,643,343) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for 8 low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding.

9 It is a goal of the General Assembly to provide supplemental funds to low-10 wealth counties to allow those counties to enhance the instructional program and student 11 achievement.

12 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
