A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR INTENSIVE FAMILY PROGRAMS IN SIX ADDITIONAL COUNTIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to	
Health and Human Services the sum of six hundred thousand dollars 1998-99 fiscal year to provide intensive family preservation pro	(\$600,000) for the

additional counties that have the highest number of children in foster care in the State.

These programs shall be developed an administered pursuant to Part 5B of Article 3 of

Chapter 143B of the General Statutes.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
