1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF
2 DEVELOPING A STATE PARK IN THE AREA OF LAKE GASTON IN
3 HALIFAX COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of twenty
8 thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for the Division to review the
9 needs of the State Parks System as described in the Plan in accordance with G.S. 113-
10 44.14(b) and determine the feasibility and cost of developing the Gaston Lake area in
11 Halifax County as a State Park. The Department shall report the results of this study to
12 the 1999 General Assembly.

13 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
