5	Section 1. G. S. 105-164.4(a)(5) reads as rewritten:
6	"(5) The rate of three percent (3%) two percent (2%) applies to the sales price
7	of food that is not otherwise exempt pursuant to G.S. 105-164.13 but
8	would be exempt pursuant to G.S. 105-164.13 if it were purchased with
9	coupons issued under the Food Stamp Program, 7 U.S.C. § 51."
10	Section 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1998.
