| Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: |
| "(28a) Vietnam Era Veteran. – Issuable to a veteran of the armed forces of the |
| United States who served during the Vietnam era and who is |
| registered owner of a motor vehicle. The Division may not issue the |
| plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 |
| applications for the plate." |
| Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. |
