| 9  | United States who served in Vietnam. The Division may not issue the                          |
| 10 | plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300                         |
| 11 | applications for the plate."   |
| 12 | Section 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:   |
| 13 | "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one           |
| 14 | registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled       |
| 15 | veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates are subject to the |
| 16 | regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee    |
