5	Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 160A-198. Curfews.</u>
8	A city may by ordinance impose a curfew on persons under the age of 18."
9	Section 2. Article 6 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
10	adding a new section to read:
11	" <u>§ 153A-142. Curfews.</u>
12	A county may by ordinance impose a curfew on persons under the age of 18."
13	Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
