| Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by |
| adding a new section to read: "§ 160A-198. Curfews. |
| A city may by ordinance impose a curfew on persons of any age less than 18." |
| Section 2. Article 6 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by |
| adding a new section to read: |
| " <u>§ 153A-142. Curfews.</u> |
| A county may by ordinance impose a curfew on persons of any age less than 18." |

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
