A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ALL INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT RECEIVE STATE FUNDS AND THEIR LAW SCHOOLS ALLOW MILITARY RECRUITING ON CAMPUS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following section to read:

"§ 116-19.1. Military recruiting in institutions of higher public education and law schools.

All constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and all institutions of higher education that receive State funds under this Chapter shall allow reasonable access of their facilities to official recruiting representatives of branches of the armed forces and military forces of the United States to inform students of the educational and occupational options in military service.

If any of these institutions have law schools associated with the institution, then the law school shall also provide law school students with reasonable access to official recruiting representatives of branches of the armed forces and military forces of the United States and shall inform interested students of the educational and occupational options in military service."

1 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
