5	COMPLAINTS OR ORDERS ARE SENT BY REGISTERED OR CERTIFIED
6	MAIL IN CONJUNCTION WITH REGULAR MAIL AND THE REGISTERED OR
7	CERTIFIED MAIL IS RETURNED, BUT THE REGULAR MAIL IS NOT
8	RETURNED WITHIN TEN DAYS AFTER MAILING.
9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
10	Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 578 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by
11	Chapter 29 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:
12	"Sec. 2. This act applies to the Cities of Greensboro and Lumberton-Greensboro,
13	Lumberton, and Rocky Mount only."
14	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
