AN ACT TO CLARIFY G.S. 153A-15 TO EXEMPT PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY AND
DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF OBTAINING
CONSENT FROM COUNTY BOARDS OF COMMISSIONERS FOR CERTAIN COUNTIES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 153A-15 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(d) The provisions of this section do not apply when the condemnation or
acquisition is for the purpose of developing, maintaining, improving, or otherwise
constructing a public water supply or distribution system, and when the condemnor or
acquiring county has:
(1) A population of greater than 60,000, based on the most recent federal
decennial census,
(2) A geographic area of less than 375 square miles, and,
(3) No river within its boundaries."
Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
