The Legislative Research Commission may study: The duties and powers of the North Carolina Cemetery Commission; (1) The limitations on the authority and powers of the North Carolina (2) Cemetery Commission to safeguard the investment of consumers in cemetery plots and perpetual care; The need for additional legislation to protect consumers when a private (3) cemetery ceases operation or is sold to a successor entity; The need for requiring plats to be filed with the register of deeds of the (4) county where the cemetery is located and the need to keep these plats up-to-date; and Any other matters related to the regulation and operation of cemeteries
