2	AN ACT TO CONFORM TO GENERAL LAW THE MANNER OF APPOINTMENT
3	OF THE TOWN ATTORNEY OF KERNERSVILLE.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Section 14 of the Charter of the Town of Kernersville, being
6	Chapter 381 of the Session Laws of 1989, reads as rewritten:
7	"Sec. 14. Town Attorney. The Board of Aldermen at their first meeting after each
8	election, shall appoint a Town Attorney who shall be an Attorney at Law licensed to
9	practice in the State of North Carolina and who need not be a resident of the Town of
10	Kernersville at the time of his appointment or thereafter. The Town Attorney shall be the
11	chief legal advisor of and Attorney for the Town and he shall perform such duties as are
12	imposed upon the chief legal officers of municipalities by law and perform such other
13	duties of a legal nature as the Board of Aldermen may require. He shall receive such
14	compensation as the Board of Aldermen may from time to time determine."
15	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. ♦
