A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE A BONUS TO ASSISTANCE TEAM MEMBERS AND TO REIMBURSE THE ACTUAL COST OF ALL REASONABLE EXPENSES INCURRED BY MEMBERS OF ASSISTANCE TEAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of Education the sum of two hundred six thousand dollars (\$206,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to provide a bonus of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) to each member of an assistance team assigned to a low-performing school. The State Board of Education shall provide the bonus retroactively for the 1997-98 school year, and shall provide the bonus for the 1998-99 school year prior to the end of the 1998-99 fiscal year. The bonus shall be prorated at one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per month for months actually served.

Section 2. G.S. 115C-105.38 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(e) Notwithstanding any other law, assistance team members will be reimbursed the actual cost of all reasonable expenses incurred."

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
