A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE MANNA FOOD BANK FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO ITS FOOD STORAGE AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITY AND THE PURCHASE OF A TRUCK.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manna Food Bank,

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manna Food Bank, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be used to replace the roof on the food storage and distribution facility and to purchase a refrigerated truck. The Manna Food Bank serves Cherokee, Graham, Clay, Swain, Macon, Jackson, Haywood, Transylvania, Madison, Buncombe, Henderson, Yancey, McDowell, Polk, Mitchell, Avery, and Rutherford Counties.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
