A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO MEET THE TECHNOLOGY NEEDS OF
THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS, THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE SYSTEM, AND THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State School Technology Fund the sum of sixty-five million dollars (\$65,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to provide for the technology needs of the public schools.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Community Colleges the sum of twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for equipment funds to provide for the technology needs of the institutions of the North Carolina Community College System.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of thirty-five million dollars (\$35,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to implement phase one of The University of North Carolina's plan for systemwide technology enhancement.

Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
