- The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of two million six hundred thousand dollars (\$2,600,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of two million six hundred thousand dollars (\$2,600,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to fund the Grassroots Science Museum Collaborative (GSMC).
- (b) The GSMC is administered by the State Museum of Natural Sciences and provides a forum to strengthen science and technology centers in the State. The membership in the Grassroots Science Museum Collaborative shall be determined and funds shall be distributed by a process developed by the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources with consultation with the Grassroots Science Museums

- which allocates fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to each Grassroots Science Museum and an additional percentage based on the operating budget of each museum.
- (c) The participating museums with grassroots science programs are located in the Cities of Asheville, Charlotte, Durham, Gastonia, Greensboro, Hickory, Raleigh, Rocky Mount, Wilson, Winston-Salem, Wilmington, and the Town of Ocean Isle.
 - Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
