G.S. 105-164.13(13b) reads as rewritten: "(13b) Prescription drugs distributed free of charge by the manufacturer, drugs, including the constituent elements and ingredients used to produce the drugs, the packaging materials, and any instructions or information about the product included in the package with the drugs." Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997, and applies to sales made on or after that date.
