March 26, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE A LIVING WAGE BY INCREASING THE STATE MINIMUM WAGE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 95-25.3(a) reads as rewritten: Every employer shall pay to each employee who in any workweek performs any work, wages of at least three dollars and eighty cents (\$3.80) per hour effective January 1, 1992, and four dollars and twenty-five cents (\$4.25) per hour effective January 1, 1993, seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour, except as otherwise provided in this section." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
