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Section 2. The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by October 15, 1998, on the extent to which University faculty members who teach instructional methods to students enrolled in schools of education are also involved with the public schools. The Board of Governors may include the information required under this section in any other related report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 1997-98 school year.
