S 1 SENATE BILL 770 Short Title: Child Care Reimbursement Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Senator Martin of Guilford. Referred to: Appropriations. April 9, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF SOCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, TO INCREASE THE PRIVATE CHILD CARE AGENCY REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR NONFEDERALLY SUBSIDIZED (NON-IV-E) CHILDREN. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, for the Child Caring Institution Fund the sum of five million one hundred ninety-two thousand three hundred dollars (\$5,192,300) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to be used to increase the private child care agency reimbursement rate for nonfederally subsidized (non-IV-E) children from thirty percent (30%) to eighty percent (80%) of the cost of care. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
