S 1 SENATE BILL 775 Short Title: Central Children's Home Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Lucas, Gulley, and Martin of Guilford. Referred to: Appropriations. April 9, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CENTRAL CHILDREN'S HOME OF NORTH CAROLINA, INC., FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Central Children's Home of North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to provide better services to homeless and neglected children. These funds may be used for capital improvements including the following: Renovating Shepherd Hall, the Center's dining hall and auditorium; (1) Constructing an emergency care cottage for girls, which can also be (2) used as a transitional living facility; Paving and curbing driveways and parking lots, along with related (3) landscaping; and Bringing all existing facilities up to current building code standards. **(4)** Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
