The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
Section 1. G.S. 18B-603(f) reads as rewritten:	
"(f) Permits Not Dependent on Elections. – The Commission may issue the	
following kinds of permits without approval at an election:	
(1)	Special occasion permits;
(2)	Limited special occasion permits;
(3)	Brown-bagging permits for private clubs and congressionally chartered
	veterans organizations;
(4)	Culinary permits, except as restricted by subdivision (d)(5);
(5)	Special one-time permits issued under G.S. 18B-1002;
(6)	All permits listed in G.S. 18B-1100;
(7)	On-premises malt beverage permits and on-premises unfortified wine
	permits for a tourism ABC establishment. establishment;

The permits authorized by G.S. 18B-1001(1), (3), (5) and (10) for sports

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
