## SESSION LAW 1999-171 HOUSE BILL 1286

## AN ACT TO MODIFY THE EXEMPTION FROM THE "MASS GATHERINGS" STATUTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130A-252(b), as amended by Section 1 of S.L. 1999-3, reads as rewritten:

"(b) The provisions of this Part do not apply to <u>a permanent stadiums stadium</u> with <u>an adjacent campgrounds campground</u> that <u>host hosts an annual events attracting</u> <u>event that has, within the previous five years, attracted</u> crowds in excess of 70,000 people. <u>The term 'stadium' includes speedways and dragways.</u>"

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 2nd day of June, 1999.
