A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CUED SPEECH CENTER, INC.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Services for the Deaf and the Hard of Hearing, the sum of two hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$260,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$260,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be allocated to the Cued Speech Center, Inc., to enable the continuation of needed services to hearing impaired children, adults, and their families.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$135,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$135,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be allocated to the Cued Speech Center, Inc., to enable the continuation of needed services to hearing impaired children.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
