SESSION LAW 2000-31 HOUSE BILL 1546

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALEXANDER, ANSON, AND SCOTLAND COUNTIES MAY PURCHASE AND CONVEY PROPERTY TO THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR USE AS CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 600 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

"Section 1. The <u>County Counties</u> of <u>Alexander, Anson, Scotland, and Stanly has have power under general law to acquire real and personal property and convey it to the State under G.S. 160A-274 or other applicable law for use as a correctional facility. facilities."</u>

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 29th day of June, 2000.
