7	The General Assembly	of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. S	ection 22.2. of S.L. 1999-237 reads as rewritten:
9	"Section 22.2. Th	e Joint Select Committee on Information Technology, established
10	pursuant to Section 2	2 of this act, shall study, evaluate, and recommend changes in the
11	current technological i	nfrastructure of the Department of the Secretary of State and the
12	Department of the Stat	te Treasurer. The Committee shall:
13	(1)	Consider the feasibility and advisability of moving the
14		Secretary of State's applications from the ITS mainframe to in-
15		house servers and allowing the Secretary of State to develop and
16		support its own computer applications;
17	(2)	Consider the need to replace, update, or modify the mainframe
18		system within the Department of the State Treasurer and existing
19		banking system which supports the State Treasurer's Banking
20		Operations Division; and

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1	(3) Study, evaluate, and recommend the level of audit staff needed
2	in the Office of the State Auditor to provide for adequate audit
3	coverage of the computer applications and installation in State
4	government.
5	The Committee shall report by April 1, 2000, December 1, 2000, to the
6	Appropriations Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives."
7	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
