H 1 **HOUSE BILL 1736\*** Short Title: Lake Lure Fishing Regulations. (Local) Sponsors: Representatives Horn; and Clary. Referred to: Local Government II. May 25, 2000 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REGULATE FISHING IN LAKE LURE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. It is unlawful to violate the following daily limitations on fishing in Lake Lure: Five trout per day per person; all trout shall be no less than 15 inches in (1)

- length:
- Five bass per day per person; largemouth bass shall be no less than 16 (2) inches in length and smallmouth bass must be no less than 14 inches in length;
- Twenty crappie per day per boat; all crappie shall be no less than 10 (3) inches long.
- Section 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
- Section 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.
  - Section 4. This act applies only to Lake Lure in Rutherford County.
- Section 5. This act becomes effective December 1, 2000. 18
