There is appropriated from the General Fund to African American 7 Atelier, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) 8 for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for 9 the 2000-2001 fiscal year for operating expenses in providing its arts programs to 10 underprivileged youth and exhibits to the citizens in the Greensboro area. 11 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
