A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR MEAT AND POULTRY TO AUTOMATE FIELD OPERATIONS FOR MEAT AND POULTRY INSPECTIONS AND FOR SALMONELLA TESTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of one million one hundred four thousand seven hundred twenty dollars (\$1,104,720) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred sixty-six thousand seventy dollars (\$266,070) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to automate field operations for meat and poultry inspections and to test for salmonella bacteria.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
