A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT ADDING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY TO THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF OAK RIDGE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The following described property is added to the corporate limits of the Town of Oak Ridge:

At a point beginning on Haw River Road following the Stokesdale boundary West to the Guilford County line then South on the Guilford line to a point 300 feet South of Hwy. 150 then easterly maintaining the 300 feet to a point 300 feet West of Bridgehead Road maintaining 300 feet West proceed South to Kristi Lane then in a southerly direction to Beaver Creek then easterly to the East side of Beeson Road to the present boundaries of the Town of Oak Ridge; North along the present boundaries of the Town of Oak Ridge to the point of beginning.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
