A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TWO ASSISTANT DISTRICT
ATTORNEYS IN PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 19A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Effective July 1, 1999, G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:
"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

22 Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
23 Department the sum of seventy-seven thousand seven hundred eighty-four dollars
24 (\$77,784) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred forty-nine thousand
25 four hundred forty-six dollars (\$149,446) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to establish the
26 two assistant district attorney positions provided for in this act.

27 Section 4. Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2000. The remainder
28 of this act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
