SESSION LAW 1999-224 HOUSE BILL 755

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES TO CREATE SERVICE DISTRICTS TO FINANCE LIGHTING AT INTERSTATE HIGHWAY INTERCHANGES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 160A-536 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(3b) Lighting at interstate highway interchange ramps."

Section 2. This act applies only to towns that, at the time the district is created, have a population of between 2,000 and 2,500 and are located in a county that has a land area of more than 946 square miles according to the 1990 federal census.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 17th day of June, 1999.
