A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO SUSPEND THE CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATION DEADLINES FOR THE ROCKINGHAM COUNTY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOLS FOR THE 1999-2000 SCHOOL YEAR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Part 6A of Article 16 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes, an applicant, with the consent of the Rockingham Board of Education, may submit a charter school application for the 1999-2000 school year to the local board of education after November 1, 1998, and the Rockingham Board of Education may act on it after February 1, 1999. The State Board of Education shall consider and act on the application at its first meeting that is at least 30 calendar days after receipt of the application.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
